

Dear Parishioners:

There is a legend which says that prior to the post resurrection account which we heard proclaimed in today's Gospel, an angel appeared to the disciples and said, "I've good news and bad news. The good news is Jesus has risen from the dead. The bad news is he's looking for you."

St. John tells us that the disciples were behind locked doors for fear of the Jews, but that might not have been their only fear. After all, Peter had denied knowing the Lord three times. All but John had abandoned him and St. Thomas refused to believe he had risen. We can only imagine their sighs of relief when he finally appeared, not with recriminations but rather with the gift of his peace. The scriptures tell us that he came, not to condemn the world but to save it. We know that his very name, Jesus, means just that, "God saves." It is no wonder then that St. John Paul II chose this second Sunday of Easter to be Divine Mercy Sunday. God's great love for us all is manifested in his mercy. Such a tremendous gift is never forced upon us. It has been said that the only unforgivable sin is the one that doesn't ask forgiveness. Think of the two men who were crucified alongside of Christ. One asked for the gift of his mercy and the other refused. Then Jesus spoke those beautiful words, "Today you will be with me in paradise." No one can ever gain or merit salvation. Thanks be to God that Jesus paid that debt in full. And so it is good that after we celebrate the new life of Jesus in his resurrection, we also celebrate his mercy which flows from the Paschal mystery.

Estimados feligreses:

Hay una leyenda que dice que antes de la historia de la pos-resurrección, que se ha proclamado en el Evangelio de hoy, un ángel se apareció a los discípulos y les dijo: "Yo tengo una buena noticia y una mala noticia. La buena noticia es que Jesús ha resucitado de entre los muertos. La mala noticia es que los está buscando".

San Juan nos dice que los discípulos estaban detrás de las puertas cerradas por miedo a los judíos, pero que eso no podría haber sido su único temor. Después de todo, Pedro había negado conocer al Señor tres veces. Todos, menos Juan, lo habían abandonado y Santo Tomás se negó a creer que había resucitado. Sólo podemos imaginar sus suspiros de alivio cuando por fin apareció, no con recriminaciones, sino con el don de su paz. Las Escrituras nos dicen que vino, no para condenar al mundo, sino para salvarlo. Sabemos que su propio nombre, Jesús, significa exactamente eso, "Dios salva." No es de extrañar entonces que San Juan Pablo II eligió este segundo domingo de Pascua para ser el domingo de la Divina Misericordia. El gran amor de Dios para todos nosotros se manifiesta en su misericordia. Tal estupendo don nunca se nos impone. Se ha dicho que el único pecado imperdonable es el que no pide perdón. Piense en los dos hombres que fueron crucificados junto a Cristo. Uno de ellos le pidió el don de su misericordia y el otro se negó. Entonces Jesús pronunció esas hermosas palabras: "Hoy estarás conmigo en el paraíso." Nadie puede ganar ni merecer la salvación. Gracias a Dios que Jesús pagó la deuda en su totalidad. Y por eso es bueno que después de celebrar la nueva vida de Jesús en su resurrección, también celebramos su misericordia que brota del misterio pascual.

How will the parish goals be determined? Parish goal calculations are based on 100 percent of the 2013, offertory (first collections) using the reported information for unrestricted plate and donations.

How much will my parish receive as part of this campaign? As part of the **We Are Living Stones** Capital Campaign, \$40 million will be allocated to help parishes meet their local needs. After the *Works of Mercy* target is met, 50% of all funds raised will stay at the parish for projects determined by local leadership.

Is our parish goal an assessment? No, the established parish goals are not an assessment. However, the first monies raised at each parish will be allocated to help meet the parish's "Works of Mercy" target. All parishes are asked to conduct a "good faith effort" and work with their assigned campaign director to achieve their goal. If, after conducting a "good faith effort" the parish does not meet its goal, the parish will not be assessed the balance.

When will parishes begin to receive their 50 percent share? Parishes in Block 1 can expect to receive their first distribution of 50% of monies collected in October of 2015. These payments will continue every quarter thereafter until the conclusion of the campaign. If the parish exceeds goal, they will receive 60% of all funds redeemed above the **We Are Living Stones** goal on the same timeline as stated above.

How will the campaign affect our parish offertory? In the short term, offertory giving should remain level, with a possible small fluctuation up or down. We make sure we communicate that parishioners are asked to consider a greater sacrifice and commitment to their Archdiocesan Church above and beyond their regular offertory giving, and should not lower their gifts to their parish in order to make a gift to this effort.


UN SOLO CORAZÓN Y UNA SOLA ALMA
