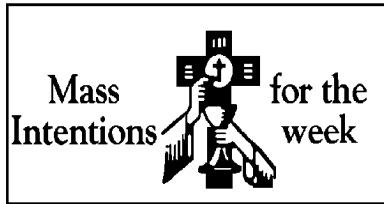

Dear Brothers and Sisters:

There is a story told of a Rabbi, a Methodist minister and a Catholic Priest who went on pilgrimage to the Holy Land. One day they visited the Sea of Galilee where St. Peter walked on water. They boarded a boat and rowed out a distance from shore where they became engrossed in ecumenical dialogue. It was about mid-morning when the Rabbi graciously offered to go ashore for some bagels and coffee. He got out of the boat and walked across the water only to return a short time later. Their dialogue continued until about noon when they were once again hungry. This time it was this Methodist minister who walked on the water and returned with lunch. Time passed very quickly and before they knew it, it was midafternoon and the sun was beating down. They were thirsty and the priest agreed that it was his turn to provide the refreshments so he stepped out of the boat but sank into the water. He attempted two more times but couldn’t walk on water. Finally, the laughing Rabbi asked the minister, “Do you think we should show him where the rocks are?”

At one time or another God asks all of us to step out in faith, that is, to do the impossible. St. Peter’s mistake was to take his eyes off of Christ, and instead, he looked down at the stormy sea. The account has been preserved for us in order to bolster our own faith when it is tested.

I am still basking in the success of our garage sale/food sale last weekend when so many of you stepped out in faith with the donation of items and food. All those who cooked, worked and patronized the event made it a wonderful community experience for the entire parish. May you be blessed for your faith and generosity as we look forward to our upcoming parish Picnic. Hats off to you!

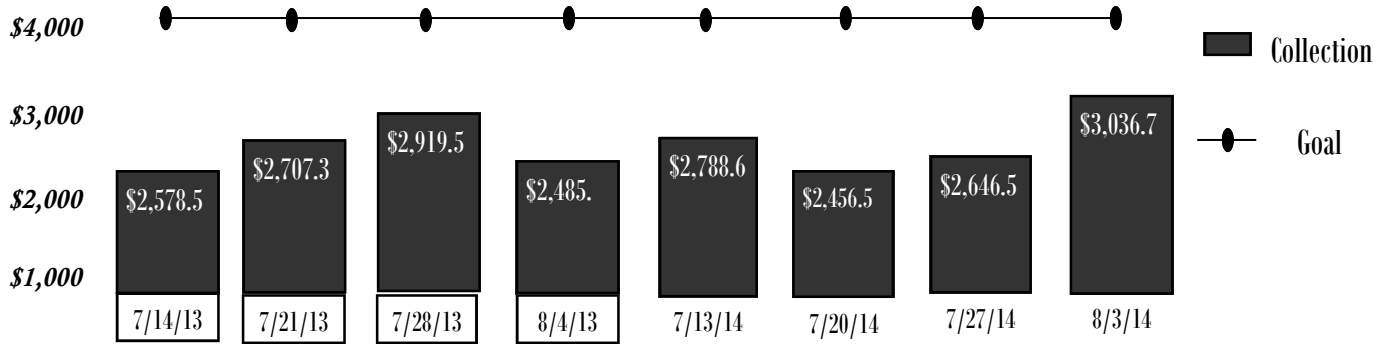
