**Dear Parishioners:**

The memory is still vivid in my mind of the time I traveled to Rome for World Youth Day 2000. It was an amazing experience I will never forget. I especially recall the day we waited for hours in the burning August heat in order to pass through the holy door of St. Peter's Basilica in the Vatican. The first thing we saw when we entered the cool interior was Michael Angelo's "Pieta." From there we made our way slowly up to the main altar. It was there that I talked to the youth about the excavation below, which unearthed the tomb with the inscription "Cephus" meaning "Rock." I opened up the same Gospel we heard proclaimed at today's Liturgy and read, "You are Peter, and upon this rock I will build my Church and the gates of the netherworld shall not prevail against it."

When I closed my Bible I could see the look of astonishment in their young faces. They felt proud to be Catholic. Soon after, the then Holy Father and now Saint John Paul II arrived by papal helicopter at the college campus called Tor Vergata. Camped out were 4,000,000 youth from all over the world. We wore radio headsets to hear him speak in our own language. He was met with love and great celebration as if a rock star had just stepped onto the stage. His message was simple but it resonated, "Do not be afraid to be witnesses to Christ and the Gospel."

Here we are 17 years later about to celebrate 100 years of faith and service at St. Francis Church where Catholicism is alive and well. May we give thanks to God for the gift of our faith and for Pope Francis, the successor of St. Peter.

## Notas del Párroco

Estimados Feligreses:

La memoria sigue viva en mi mente del tiempo que viajé a Roma para la Jornada Mundial de la Juventud 2000. Fue una experiencia increíble que nunca olvidaré. Recuerdo especialmente el día cuando esperamos durante muchas horas en el ardiente calor de agosto para poder pasar por la Puerta Santa de la Basílica de San Pedro en el Vaticano. Lo primero que vimos cuando entramos al fresco interior de la basílica fue "la Piedad" de Miguel Ángel. De allí nos dirigimos lentamente hacia el altar principal. Fue allí donde platiqué con los jóvenes sobre la excavación de abajo, que desenterró la tumba con la inscripción "Cephus" que significa "Roca." Abrí el mismo Evangelio que oímos proclamado en la liturgia de hoy y leí: "Tú eres Pedro y sobre esta piedra edificaré mi Iglesia. Los poderes del infierno no prevalecerán sobre ella..."

Cuando cerré mi Biblia pude ver el asombro en sus caras jóvenes. Se sentían orgullosos de ser católicos. Poco después, el entonces Santo Padre y ahora San Juan Pablo II llegó por helicóptero papal al campus universitario llamado Tor Vergata. Acampaban allá cuatro millones de jóvenes del mundo entero. Llevábamos auriculares de radio para escucharlo hablar en nuestro propio idioma. Fue recibido con amor y gran celebración como si una estrella de rock acabara de subir al escenario. Su mensaje fue simple pero resonó: "No tengan miedo de ser testigos de Cristo y del Evangelio."

Aquí nos encontramos 17 años después, a punto de celebrar 100 años de fe y servicio en la Iglesia de San Francisco donde el catolicismo está vivo y está bien. Demos gracias a Dios por el don de nuestra fe y por el Papa Francisco, sucesor de San Pedro.

### BE A ROCK

Peter's history as a follower or friend of Jesus is a bit spotty. It might be natural to wonder if Jesus, in giving him the keys to the kingdom, didn't feel a bit like a parent giving a teenager the keys to the family car. But it was at the moment when God's power and presence broke through everything else to raise up Peter's great profession of faith in Christ as Messiah that Jesus chose to establish the bond between the loving, forgiving mercy of heaven and our vocation to be witnesses of that love, mercy, and forgiveness on earth.

Like any parent, Jesus no doubt foresaw the failings, the irresponsible maneuvers or impaired senses, the collisions that the church would be headed for. But, most importantly, he also saw us at that moment as God prefers to see us: capable of manifesting great faith, with a willingness to remain at the feet of Christ to understand what it truly means to be Messiah and Christ. As the letter to the Romans points out to us today, we have not known the mind or the wisdom of God, but God knows us and still chooses to manifest the reign of justice, joy, beauty, and peace through us. Let this be our vocation. Let us always strive to be solid ground on which the church of Jesus Christ can be founded and on which it can continue to be built.

La historia de Pedro como seguidor o amigo de Jesús es en poco irregular. Resulta natural preguntarnos si Jesús, al darle las llaves del Reino, no se sintió un poco como el padre que le entrega a su adolescentes las llaves del auto de la familia. 
