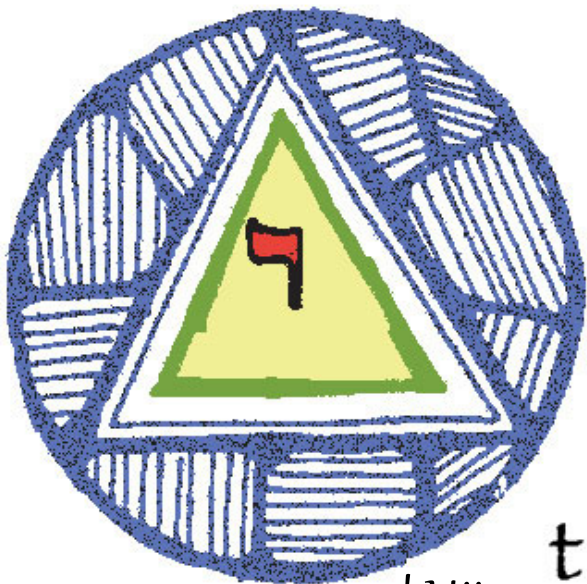

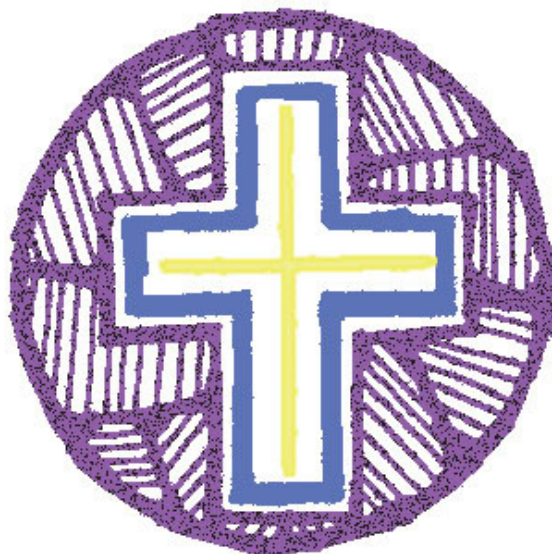
Parroquia San Francisco de Asís

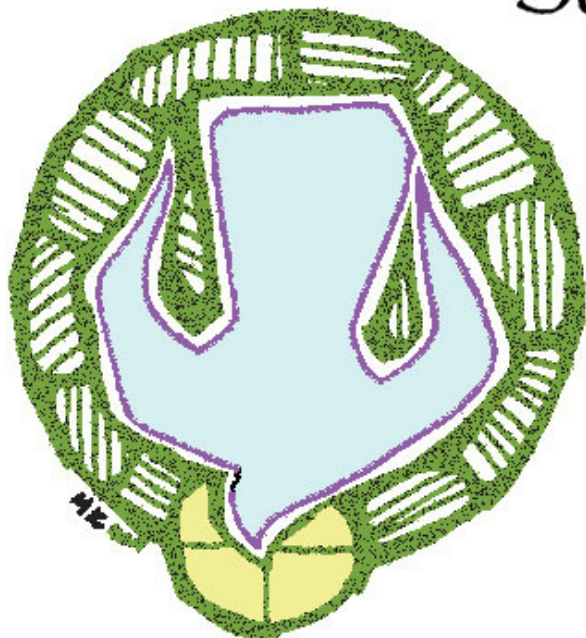

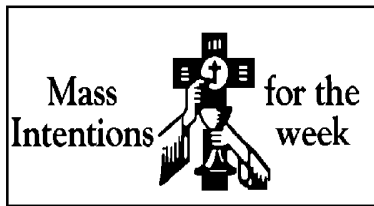

Dear Brothers and Sisters:

One day a young man walked up to the priest who was his college theology professor and said, "I am losing my faith. I can no longer believe in God." He was shocked to hear the priest's response: "Maybe that's not such a bad thing. Perhaps your concept of God is so false that it should be rejected."

It has been said that humanity was so wrong about who God is that he had to come in the flesh to tell us personally.

The Solemnity of the Holy Trinity was instituted by Pope John XXII in the fourteenth century after many centuries of reflection about God. The first four centuries of the church's history were spent trying to establish a creed which defined that God is three persons with one divine nature. What we now accept by faith was once the cause of battles, heresies and councils.

Everyone loves a mystery. We like to see them solved. But not all mysteries can be solved. If they could, there would be no need for faith. The mystery of the Holy Trinity falls under that category. It is the first and central mystery of our Catholic Faith. Countless analogies have been used to explain this first mystery of our faith. For example, water can take three forms, solid (ice), liquid (water) or gas (vapor) or a leaf of clover which is three yet one. Like the college student, we are faced with the reality of accepting God on his terms; that is to say a community of persons who while different live in perfect love. The more we try to live out that unconditional love in our own families and community the more we will come to know the Holy Trinity by heart, for God is love.

Notas del Pastor

Queridos hermanos,

Un día un joven se acercó al sacerdote que era su profesor de teología de la universidad y le dijo: "Estoy perdiendo mi fe. Ya no puedo creer en Dios." Él se sorprendió al oír la respuesta del sacerdote: "Tal vez esto no sea tan malo. Tal vez tu concepto de Dios es tan falsa que se debe rechazar."

Se ha dicho que la humanidad estaba tan equivocada acerca de quién es Dios que Él tuvo que encarnarse para decírnoslo personalmente.

La solemnidad de la Santísima Trinidad fue instituida por el Papa Juan XXII en el siglo XIV, después de muchos siglos de reflexión sobre Dios. Los primeros cuatro siglos de la historia de la iglesia fueron gastados tratando de establecer un credo que definiera a Dios como tres personas con una naturaleza divina. Lo que ahora aceptamos por la fe, una vez fue la causa de batallas, herejías y concilios.

A todo el mundo le encanta un misterio. Nos gusta verlos resueltos. Pero no todos los misterios se pueden resolver. Si se pudieran resolver, no habría necesidad de la fe. El misterio de la Santísima Trinidad forma parte de dicha categoría. Se trata del primero y central misterio de nuestra fe católica. Analogías innumerables se han utilizado para explicar este primer misterio de nuestra fe. Por ejemplo, el agua puede existir bajo tres formas, sólida (el hielo), líquida (agua) o gas (el vapor); también una hoja de trébol, que es tres en una. Al igual que el estudiante de la universidad, nos enfrentamos a la realidad de aceptar a Dios en sus términos; es decir, una comunidad de personas, que mientras sean distintas, viven en el amor perfecto. Cuanto más tratamos de vivir ese amor incondicional en nuestras propias familias y en la comunidad, más vamos a llegar a conocer a la Santísima Trinidad en la profundidad del corazón, porque Dios es amor.

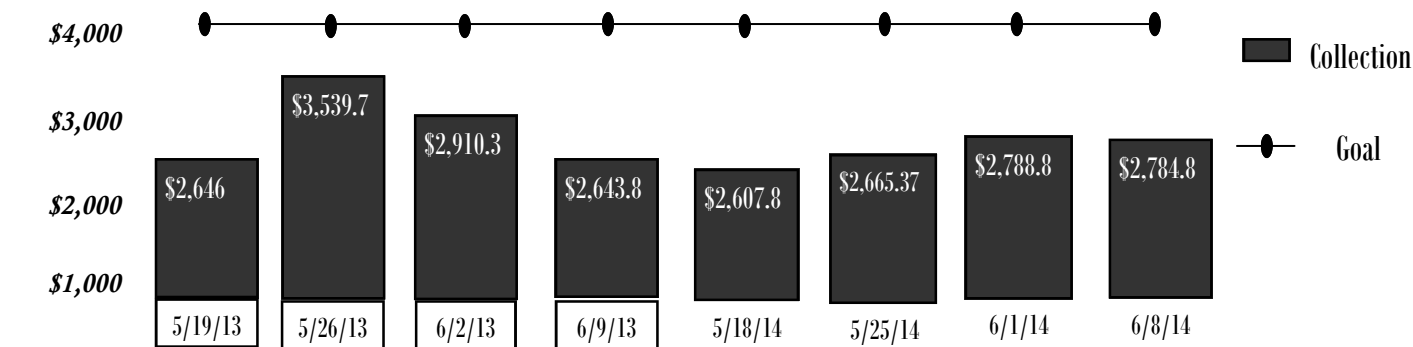
