Dear Parishioners:

Before coming to Hackensack, 18 of my 30 years of priesthood were lived serving in the Southeast of this country where places like Florida, Georgia and North Carolina were only 3% Catholic. Although the southern Baptists and Evangelicals are for the most part very fine people, they often had very distorted notions of what we believe in the Catholic Church. I recall occasions when, having been called out in the middle of the night to bring the Sacraments to a dying patient in the hospital, a Baptist band of preachers would trap me in a deserted hallway and begin to yell at me for teaching lies to the people for which I would be damned to hell. They would call me an idol worshiper and a cannibal.

While such experiences were extreme to say the least, I did come to see some common threads. I could never understand that while many fundamentalists interpret the Bible literally, when it comes to chapter 6 of John's Gospel, his Bread of Life Discourse, they see the words of Christ as merely symbolic. You may recall that many left Jesus at that teaching saying it was "too hard." The Lord then refused to compromise and asks his disciples, "Will you leave me too?"

Still I find that converts to Catholicism tend to treasure more the gift of the Eucharist than we "cradle Catholics." We may even allow the reception of the Lord to become routine or take him for granted. This can easily happen, when we emphasize one of the two "real presences" over the other; Jesus truly present in the Blessed Sacrament and Jesus truly present in his Mystical Body or in us who receive him. Today many members of our parish will participate in the Corpus Christi procession. May our public witness of faith help us to grow in love for Him in the Eucharist and in each other.

Notas del Párroco

Estimados Feligreses:

Antes de venir a Hackensack, viví 18 de mis 30 años de sacerdocio sirviendo en el sudeste de este país, en lugares como la Florida, Georgia y Carolina del Norte donde había sólo un 3% de católicos. Aunque los bautistas y evangélicos del sur son en su mayoría personas muy buenas, a menudo tenían nociones muy distorsionadas de lo que creemos en la Iglesia Católica. Recuerdo ocasiones en la cual, fui llamado en medio de la noche para traer los sacramentos a un paciente moribundo en el hospital, un grupo de predicadores bautistas me atraparon en un pasillo desierto y me regañaban por enseñar mentiras a la gente por la cual yo sería condenado al infierno. Me llamaban idólatra y caníbal.

Si bien esas experiencias fueron extremas por decir lo menos, llegué a ver algunos hilos comunes. Nunca llegué a entender porque mientras muchos fundamentalistas interpretan la Biblia literalmente, cuando se trata del capítulo 6 del Evangelio de Juan, el Discurso del Pan de Vida, ellos ven las palabras de Cristo simplemente simbólicas. Pueden recordar que muchos dejaron a Jesús por esa enseñanza diciendo que era "demasiado duro." El Señor entonces se negó a comprometer y les pregunta a sus discípulos: "¿Me dejarán también?"

Sin embargo, me parece que los convertidos al catolicismo tienden a atesorar más el don de la Eucaristía que los que nacimos católicos. Incluso podemos permitir que la recepción del Señor sea rutinaria o la subestimamos. Esto puede suceder fácilmente, cuando damos énfasis a una de las dos "presencias reales" sobre la otra--Jesús verdaderamente presente en el Santísimo Sacramento y Jesús verdaderamente presente en su Cuerpo Místico o en nosotros que lo recibimos. Hoy muchos miembros de nuestra parroquia participarán en la procesión del Corpus Christi. Que nuestro testimonio público de la fe nos ayude a crecer en el amor por Él en la Eucaristía y en los demás.

GRUPO DE ORACIÓN


