Dear Parishioners:

My good friend, Antonio, was born and raised in Mexico. He tells the story from his childhood when his father took him to work on a ranch. While out in the fields a terrible storm blew up so they sought shelter under a grove of trees. His father, realizing they were in greater danger because of the lightning striking all around them, carried little Antonio back into the clearing. Hail stones the size of golf balls dropped relentlessly from the sky so his father placed him on the ground and then covered him with his own body. When the worst of the storm finally subsided the two returned to their home to change out of their drenched clothes. It was then that he saw the welts on his father's body which he sustained while sheltering his little son from the blows of the hail.

Antonio explained to me that this became his image of the love of God. It is a powerful one. Today we hear Jesus say that our heavenly Father loves each of us "more than a whole flock of sparrows." That does not mean that we won't have to face the "storms" of opposition as did Jeremiah or St. Paul in today's readings. It has been said that it is our attitude rather than our aptitude which will determine our altitude. Jesus counsels us to be strong-willed, prudent, persevering and filled with faith. If God loves his created birds so much that not one will fall without his consent, then we should rejoice that he loves and cares for us even more. He therefore commands us to be unintimidated. Regardless of the evil forces which pull us down, his graces are far stronger to lift us up. He will never let us fall farther from one of his hands than he can catch with the other. Amen.

Estimados Feligreses:

Mi buen amigo Antonio nació y creció en México. Cuenta una historia de su infancia sobre cuando su padre lo llevó a trabajar en un rancho. Mientras que estuvieron en los campos vino repentinamente una tormenta terrible. Buscaron refugio bajo un bosquecillo. Su padre, al darse cuenta de que se encontraban en mayor peligro por el relámpago que los rodeaba, llevó al pequeño Antonio de vuelta a la claridad. Las piedras de granizo del tamaño de pelotas de golf caían incesantemente del cielo. Por eso, su padre lo colocó en el suelo y luego lo cubrió con su propio cuerpo. Cuando lo peor de la tormenta finalmente pasó, los dos regresaron a su casa para cambiarse de la ropa empapada. Fue entonces cuando Antonio vio en la espalda de su papá las ronchas que sostuvo mientras protegía a su pequeño hijo de los golpes del granizo.

Antonio me explicó que esto se convirtió en su imagen del amor de Dios. Es profundo. Hoy oímos a Jesús decir que nuestro Padre celestial nos ama a cada uno de nosotros "más que a toda una parvada de gorriones." Eso no significa que no tendremos que enfrentar las "tormentas" de la oposición como lo hicieron Jeremías o San Pablo en las lecturas de hoy. FEAR NOT

How do people find hope in the face of suffering and death? That is the question addressed by today's scriptures. We hear of the suffering of Jeremiah and the psalmist. We hear of the death that "reigned from Adam to Moses" (Romans 5:14). We hear of the fears of the Twelve as Jesus sends them out into the world to preach and heal.

Through all this tribulation one message rings out loud and clear – "Do not be afraid!" The God who saved Jeremiah and the psalmist and Jesus is fully present to save us through the gracious gift of Jesus Christ. We have nothing and no one to fear.

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

At the heart of today's solemnity is a Eucharistic procession, held in many parishes, that calls to mind the procession of Holy Thursday, yet has a purpose different from the somber adoration in the night watch. In the late Middle Ages, a procession through the city with the Blessed Sacrament was an occasion of heartfelt joy and great emotion. In a time when people seldom approached the altar to receive Holy Communion, the procession through the streets, past homes and workplaces, was a vibrant reminder that Christ was with them as a dear companion and guide.

Every year on this day, a joyful procession winds through the streets of Rome from the Lateran cathedral. A few years ago, Pope John Paul II, deeply moved at the sight of the throng accompanying the sacred host, said that we ought to feel profoundly united with the faithful everywhere in the world at such a moment. "Before our mind's eye all the Churches of the world, from East to West, from North to South, are present." Originally this feast was on the Thursday after Trinity Sunday, but after the calendar reform of 1970, its title was expanded from "Corpus Christi" to "The Body and Blood of Christ" and in the United States it was moved to the Sunday after Trinity Sunday. Even though Easter season ended two weeks ago, this beautiful feast is aglow with Easter light.


