



Dear Parishioners:

Recently I read a moving article about a couple whose child was born mentally impaired. They were crushed, of course. Still, they loved him as they would any child of theirs. They built a bedroom with glass walls so that wherever they were in the house they would be able to keep an eye on him. For seventeen years, the mother slept next to the boy with her hand next to his heart. If he ever started having trouble breathing, she would be able to wake up and give him artificial respiration. For seventeen years they lived this way.

One sad day, however, one of their neighbor's daughters fell from a tree and hurt her arm. The mother left her son to rush the girl to the hospital. As she was standing in the emergency room of the hospital with the little girl, her husband came in carrying the body of her son. He had died while she was at the hospital. His father had tried vainly to revive him. As the boy lay before them in peace, the parents wept. But then they gave thanks to God for the gift of their son. "For," his mother said, "he taught us how to love."

God is love. He cannot will evil whether it be moral or metaphysical. Couldn't the same Jesus who raised the daughter of Jairus and healed the woman with the hemorrhage in today's gospel have prevented their illnesses in the first place? He wants us to respond in faith to life's problems. Learning to love is the greatest healing that faith can bring about in our lives.

Notas del Pastor

Estimados feligreses:

Recientemente leí un artículo emotivo sobre una pareja cuyo hijo nació con problemas mentales. Ellos fueron destrozados, por supuesto. Aun así, ellos lo amaban como lo hubieran hecho con cualquier niño suyo. Construyeron un dormitorio con paredes de cristal para que donde quiera que se encontraran podrían vigilarlo. Durante diecisiete años, la madre dormía al lado del chico con la mano junta a su corazón. Si alguna vez empezó a tener problemas de respirar, ella podría despertarse y darle respiración artificial. Durante diecisiete años vivieron de esta manera.

Un día triste, sin embargo, una de las hijas de su vecino cayó de un árbol y se lastimó el brazo. La madre dejó a su hijo para llevar a la niña al hospital. Mientras que ella estaba en la sala de emergencia del hospital con la niña, su esposo llegó cargando el cadáver de su hijo. Se había muerto mientras la mamá estaba en el hospital. Su padre había intentado en vano reanimarlo. Viéndolo ante ellos estirado en paz, los padres empezaron a llorar. Pero luego le dieron gracias a Dios por el don de su hijo. "Porque," dijo la madre, "él nos enseñó a amar."

Dios es amor. Él no puede desear el mal, ya sea moral o metafísico. ¿No pudiera el mismo Jesús, que resucitó a la hija de Jairo y sanó a la mujer con la hemorragia en el evangelio de hoy, prevenir sus enfermedades en primer lugar? Él quiere que respondamos con fe a los problemas de la vida. Aprender a amar es la mayor sanación que la fe puede ocasionar en nuestras vidas.

How will the parish goals be determined? Parish goal calculations are based on 100 percent of the 2013, offertory (first collections) using the reported information for unrestricted plate and donations.

How much will my parish receive as part of this campaign? As part of the *We Are Living Stones* Capital Campaign, \$40 million will be allocated to help parishes meet their local needs. After the *Works of Mercy* target is met, 50% of all funds raised will stay at the parish for projects determined by local leadership.

Is our parish goal an assessment? No, the established parish goals are not an assessment. However, the first monies raised at each parish will be allocated to help meet the parish's "Works of Mercy" target. All parishes are asked to conduct a "good faith effort" and work with their assigned campaign director to achieve their goal. If, after conducting a "good faith effort" the parish does not meet its goal, the parish will not be assessed the balance.

When will parishes begin to receive their 50 percent share? Parishes in Block 1 can expect to receive their first distribution of 50% of monies collected in October of 2015. These payments will continue every quarter thereafter until the conclusion of the campaign. If the parish exceeds goal, they will receive 60% of all funds redeemed above the *We Are Living Stones* goal on the same timeline as stated above.

How will the campaign affect our parish offertory? In the short term, offertory giving should remain level, with a possible small fluctuation up or down. We make sure we communicate that parishioners are asked to consider a greater sacrifice and commitment to their Archdiocesan Church above and beyond their regular offertory giving, and should not lower their gifts to their parish in order to make a gift to this effort.


