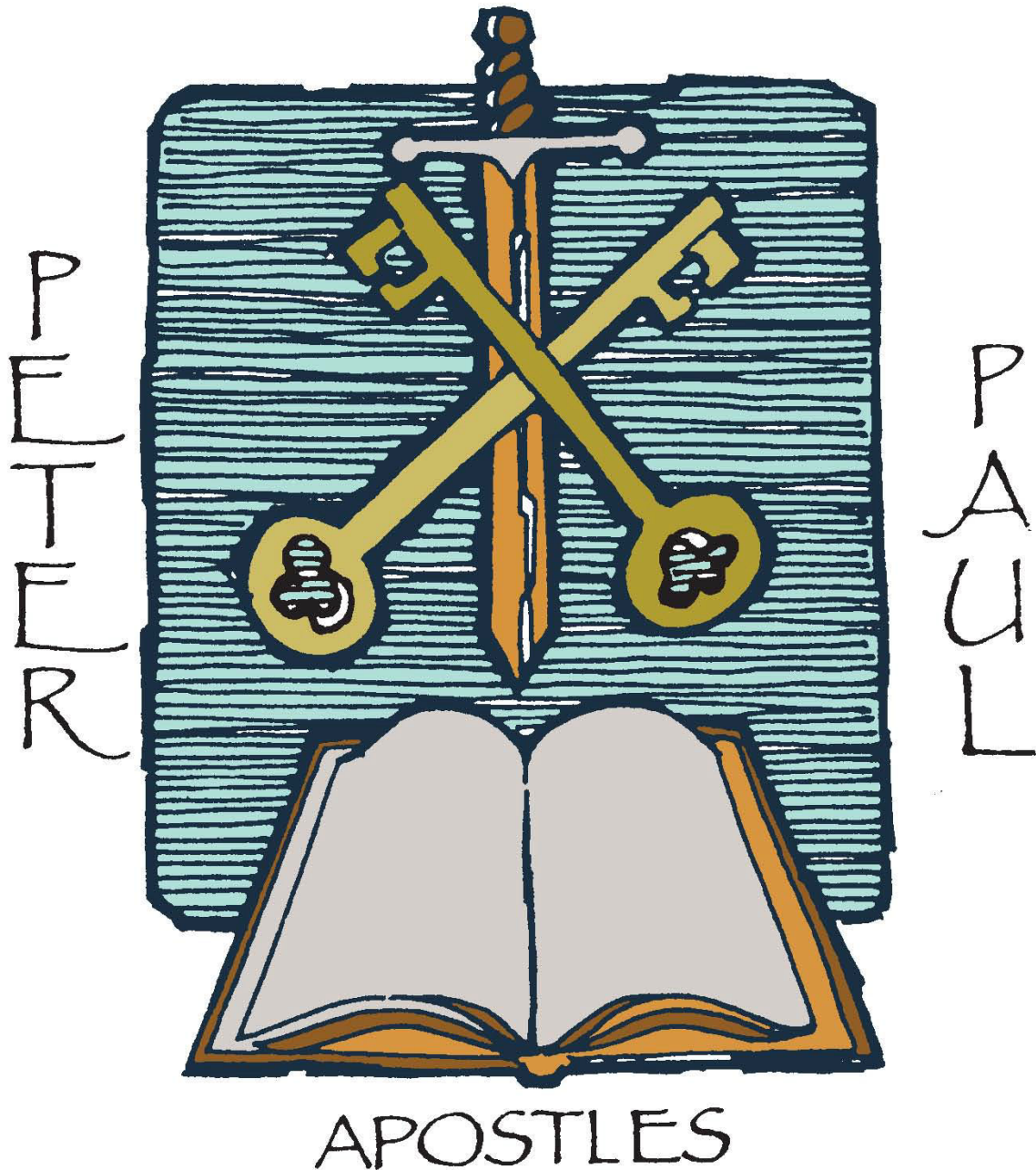

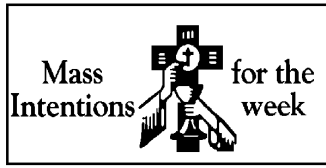

Dear Brothers and Sisters:

“I say to you, you are Peter, and upon this rock I will build my Church, and the gates of the netherworld shall not prevail against it.” These words of Jesus were proclaimed at Mass today on the Solemnity of Sts. Peter and Paul. They have proven to be prophetic and a tremendous consolation in these troubled times.

If I could have one wish for all of the parishioners of our parish of St. Francis, it would be that everyone might have the opportunity to visit Rome and the Basilicas of Peter and Paul. Besides the massive structures which were erected long before the era of modern technology and aside from their art and architectural beauty, they are a parable of the Church itself. Just as Jesus foretold, excavation has shown that the main altar of St. Peter's, where the pope celebrates Mass, is right above the tomb of the Apostle which bears his name, “Cepheus.” The colonnade of columns stretching outward from either side of the front of the basilica gives one the impression that the arms of the Church reach out to draw the world into its embrace with Peter standing at the center.

The Basilica of St. Paul, on the other hand, is strategically located outside the walls of the ancient city. It represents the outward thrust of the Church's mission to the gentile world where Paul preached the gospel. His tomb below is presently being excavated.

Although sometimes in tension, both thrusts which the two apostles represent are essential for the life of the Church. We are blessed to profess an apostolic Faith.

Notas del Pastor

Queridos hermanos,

"Yo te digo, tú eres Pedro, y sobre esta piedra edificaré mi Iglesia, y las puertas del Hades no prevalecerán contra ella." Estas palabras de Jesús fueron proclamadas en la misa de hoy, en la solemnidad de los Santos Pedro y Pablo. Las palabras se han mostrado proféticas y un tremendo consuelo en estos tiempos difíciles.

Si pudiera lograr un deseo para todos los feligreses de nuestra parroquia de San Francisco, sería que todo el mundo pudiera tener la oportunidad de visitar Roma y las Basílicas de Pedro y Pablo. Además de las enormes estructuras que se construyeron mucho antes de la era de la tecnología moderna y no contando su arte y belleza arquitectónica, las Basílicas son una parábola de la Iglesia misma. Así como Jesús predijo, las excavaciones han demostrado que el altar mayor de San Pedro, donde se celebra Misa el Papa, está justo encima de la tumba del apóstol que lleva su nombre, "Cefeo." La columnata que se extiende hacia cada lado de la fachada de la basílica nos da la impresión de que los brazos de la Iglesia se extienden para abrazar al mundo entero con San Pedro en el centro.

La Basílica de San Pablo, en cambio, se encuentra estratégicamente ubicada fuera de las murallas de la antigua ciudad. Representa el empuje de la misión de la Iglesia hacia el exterior al mundo de los gentiles donde Pablo pronunció el evangelio. Actualmente se está excavando su tumba que está debajo de la basílica.

Aunque a veces en tensión, ambos empujes que representan los dos apóstoles son esenciales para la vida de la Iglesia. Tenemos la gran bendición de profesar una fe apostólica.

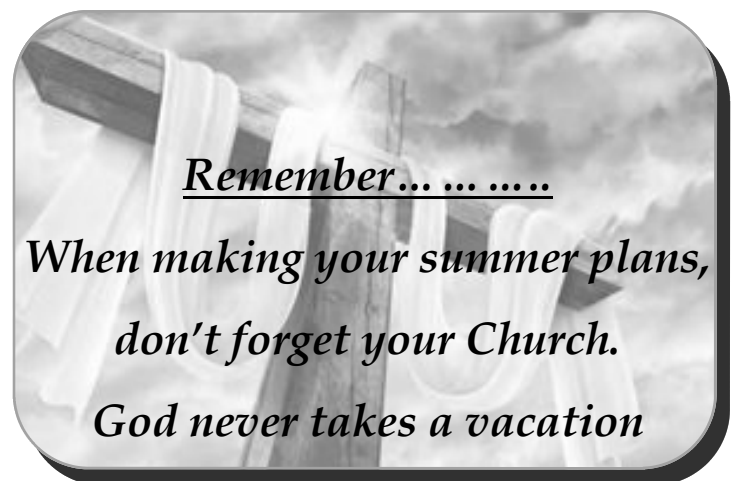

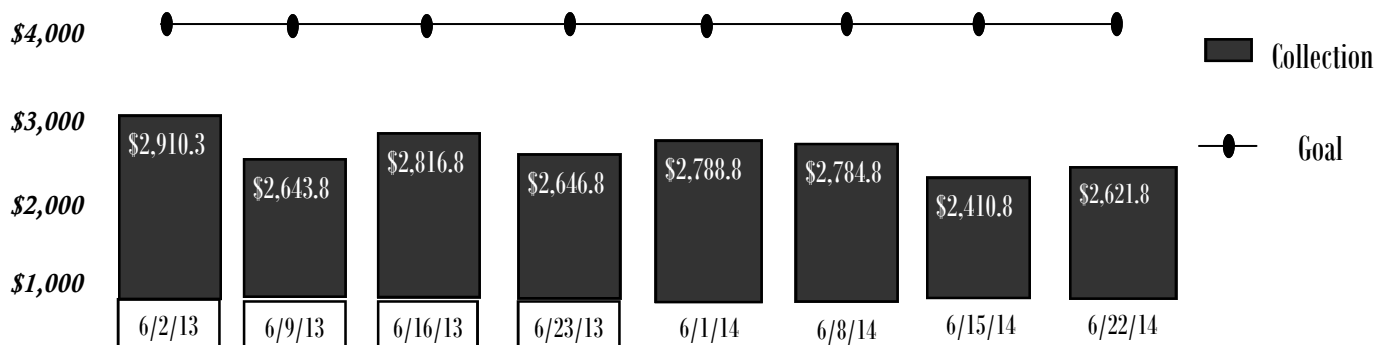
