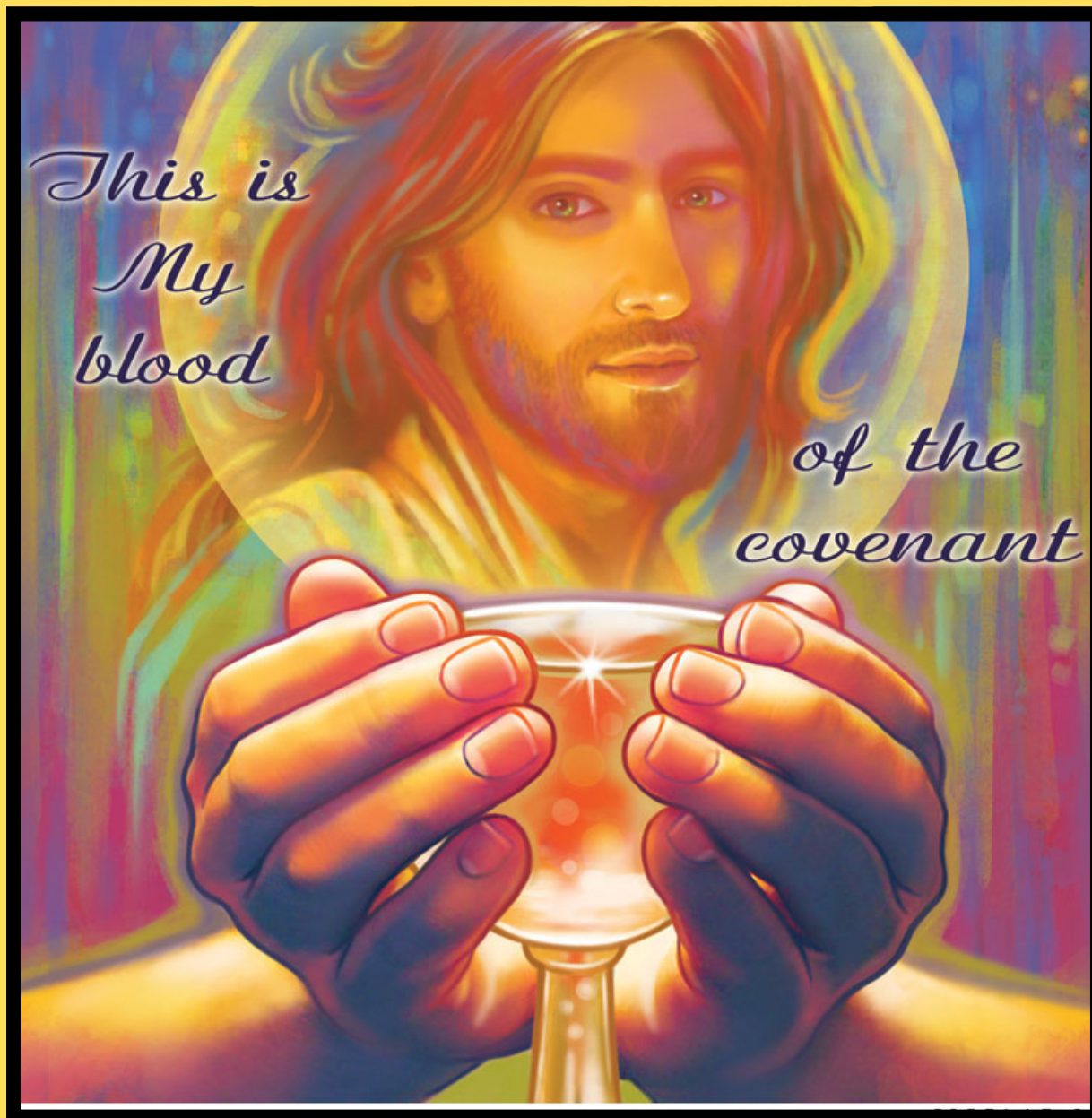

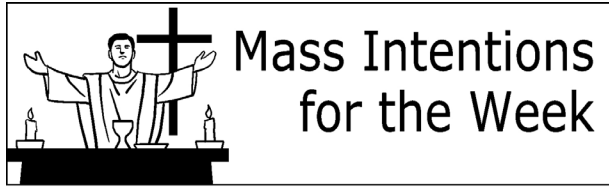

Dear Parishioners:

Prior to my arrival at St. Francis in Hackensack, Fr. Francisco Arredondo revived the tradition of the Corpus Christi procession with the Blessed Sacrament through the streets of our neighborhood. I am glad he did so because in recent years more emphasis has been placed on the presence of our Lord in the Mystical Body of Christ and less on the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist. The pendulum tends to swing back and forth during our church history. In truth both are essential in our Catholic Faith.

Did you know that that a priest is not allowed to celebrate Mass alone? There has to be at least one altar server or person present to represent the church. Today's feast helps us to appreciate both aspects of the Body and Blood of Christ. As a priest I am privileged to celebrate the Eucharist every day. When I can't, on rare occasion because of sickness or travel, my day seems terribly lacking. In all truth, this mystery is the center of my life.

For many years I have interviewed and prepared converts to the Faith in the RCIA program. A common thread in the candidates for the Sacraments of initiation is their attraction to the Eucharist. They feel a closeness to God that other religions cannot provide. The word most often used by them is awe. For most of us this closeness of the real presence can easily become routine, but it is the greatest of all treasures. Would that we could receive Jesus every time as if it were the first time.

Notas del Pastor

Estimados feligreses:

Antes de mi llegada a San Francisco en Hackensack, el Padre Francisco Arredondo revivió la tradición de la procesión con el Santísimo Sacramento por las calles de nuestro barrio para la Solemnidad de El Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo. Me alegro de que lo hiciera porque en los últimos años se ha puesto más énfasis en la presencia de nuestro Señor en el Cuerpo Místico de Cristo y menos en la presencia real de Cristo en la Eucaristía. El péndulo tiende a balancearse hacia atrás y hacia adelante en la historia de la iglesia. En realidad las dos verdades son esenciales en nuestra fe católica.

¿Sabía que a un sacerdote no se le permite celebrar la misa a solas? Tiene que haber al menos un acólito u otra persona presente para representar la Iglesia. La fiesta de hoy nos ayuda a apreciar los dos aspectos del Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo. Como sacerdote tengo el privilegio de celebrar la Eucaristía todos los días. En raras ocasiones cuando no puedo, por razones de enfermedad o de viaje, mi día parece terriblemente escaso. En verdad, este misterio es el centro de mi vida.

Durante muchos años he entrevistado y preparado a conversos a la fe en el programa de RICA. Un hilo común en los candidatos para los sacramentos de iniciación es su atracción a la Eucaristía. Se sienten una cercanía a Dios que otras religiones no pueden proporcionar. La palabra más utilizada por ellos es el temor reverencial. Para la mayoría de nosotros esta proximidad a la presencia real puede convertirse fácilmente en la rutina, pero es el más grande de todos los tesoros. Ojalá pudiéramos recibir a Jesús cada vez como si fuera la primera vez.

How will the parish goals be determined? Parish goal calculations are based on 100 percent of the 2013, offertory (first collections) using the reported information for unrestricted plate and donations.

How much will my parish receive as part of this campaign? As part of the *We Are Living Stones* Capital Campaign, \$40 million will be allocated to help parishes meet their local needs. After the *Works of Mercy* target is met, 50% of all funds raised will stay at the parish for projects determined by local leadership.

Is our parish goal an assessment? No, the established parish goals are not an assessment. However, the first monies raised at each parish will be allocated to help meet the parish's "Works of Mercy" target. All parishes are asked to conduct a "good faith effort" and work with their assigned campaign director to achieve their goal. If, after conducting a "good faith effort" the parish does not meet its goal, the parish will not be assessed the balance.

When will parishes begin to receive their 50 percent share? Parishes in Block 1 can expect to receive their first distribution of 50% of monies collected in October of 2015. These payments will continue every quarter thereafter until the conclusion of the campaign. If the parish exceeds goal, they will receive 60% of all funds redeemed above the *We Are Living Stones* goal on the same timeline as stated above.

How will the campaign affect our parish offertory? In the short term, offertory giving should remain level, with a possible small fluctuation up or down. We make sure we communicate that parishioners are asked to consider a greater sacrifice and commitment to their Archdiocesan Church above and beyond their regular offertory giving, and should not lower their gifts to their parish in order to make a gift to this effort.

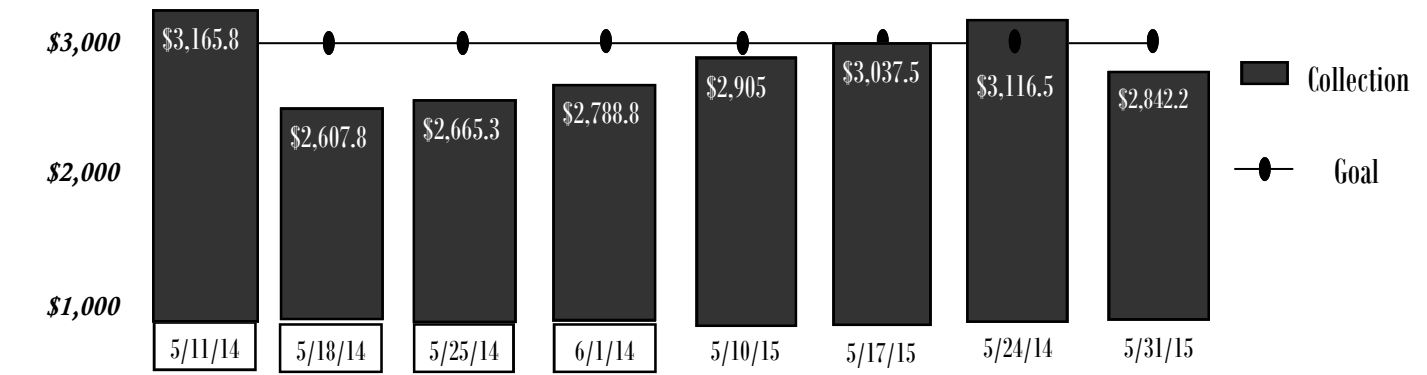
