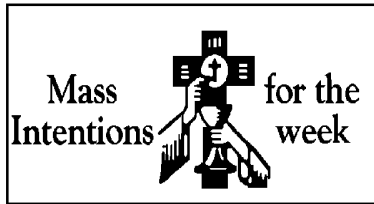

Dear Brothers and Sisters:

I have a good friend who happens to be a dentist for children. One day he asked me to stop by his office in order to bless his practice. On the wall hung a scroll with the title "I can Take It Club." Underneath the title were hundreds of names. When I asked why the names were there he explained that they were children who had pledged to face the horrors of the dentist's drill with courage. He went on to say it's absolutely incredible how signing that pledge changes children from crybabies to "little soldiers."

We could never overestimate the change that the spirit brought at Pentecost. The Holy Spirit is inextricably linked to creation as we learn from the Book of Genesis. From the very beginning until the present day he has continue to create a new those who embrace him. We see this happen with the apostles who were huddled together in the upper room where Jesus celebrated the Last Supper or first mass. He promised to send them and advocate who would lead them into all truth.

There is a legend that tells of Jesus after his ascension into heaven. Looking down from heaven's window an angel asks him, "What provisions have you made so that your mission of love and mercy may continue to reach the whole world?" Jesus pointed to the twelve gathered together in prayer. The angel then asked, "But what if they should fail? Have you no plan B?" The Lord responded, "There is no plan "B" I'm counting on them."

Like the children who pledged to be members of the "I Can Take It Club" the apostles went from being a group of weak and fearful men to courageous witnesses for Christ. Today we pray that we may be recreated by the Holy Spirit in their footsteps.

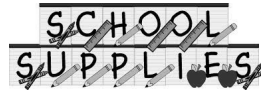

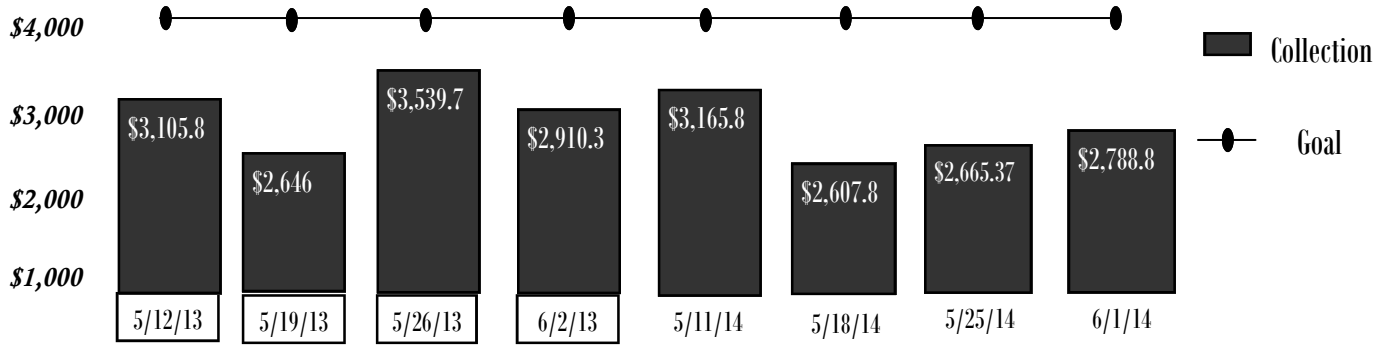
