
### First Friday - Eucharistic Adoration

Dear Parishioners:

A young woman walked into a fabric shop and asked the proprietor if she had any kind of material that was noisy, rustling and white. The proprietor searched the inventory and finally found two bolts of material that fit the description. As she was cutting the fabric to the customer's specifications, the proprietor's curiosity got the best of her and she asked the woman why she wanted such unusual and noisy cloth. The young woman replied, "You see, I am making a wedding gown, and my fiancé is blind. When I walk down the aisle, I want him to know when I've arrived at the altar, so he won't be embarrassed."

All of the Scriptures are summed up in Jesus' commandment of love. True love is concerned about only one thing, the good of the other. Anything else is only a disguise for selfishness.

Some mighty powerful thoughts can be expressed in very tiny sentences. I would like to cite two powerful examples on the subject of love. Both of the sentences have only three words. The first is: "I love you." When those words are spoken sincerely and intelligently, they are about the three nicest words you could ever hope to hear. But if they are said without thought, or worse, deceptively, they have no beauty and become the bearers of serious harm.

There is an old saying, "You can be kissed by a fool and fooled by a kiss." Ultimately all of the Scriptures are summed up in just three words, "God is love." May our words and actions bear witness to this truth.

## Notas del Pastor

Estimados feligreses:

Una mujer joven entró en una tienda de tejidos y le preguntó a la dueña si tuviera cualquier tipo de tela que fuera ruidosa, crujiente y blanca. La propietaria buscó en las existencias y, finalmente, encontró dos rollos de tela adecuada. Mientras ella cortaba la tela para las especificaciones de la clienta, le venció la curiosidad de la dueña y le preguntó a la mujer por qué quería esa tela inusual y ruidosa. La joven respondió: "Es que estoy haciendo un vestido de novia, y mi novio es ciego. Cuando llevo al altar, yo quiero que él sepa cuando llegue al altar, para que no se sienta avergonzado."

Todas las Escrituras se resumen en el mandamiento del amor de Jesús. El amor verdadero se preocupa por una sola cosa, el bien del otro. Cualquier otra cosa es un disfraz para el egoísmo.

Algunos pensamientos poderosos pueden expresarse en frases muy pequeñas. Me gustaría citar dos ejemplos de gran alcance sobre el tema del amor. Ambas frases tienen sólo tres palabras. La primera es: "Te amo." Cuando estas palabras se dicen con sincera e inteligentemente, son entre las tres palabras más bonitas que jamás se podrían escuchar. Pero si se dicen sin pensar, o peor, engañosamente, no son bellas; se convierten en portadores de un daño grave.

Hay un viejo refrán que dice, "Usted puede ser besado por un tonto y engañado por un beso." Básicamente, todas las Escrituras se resumen en tres palabras: "Dios es amor." Que nuestras palabras y acciones atestigüen a esta verdad.

**How will the parish goals be determined?** Parish goal calculations are based on 100 percent of the 2013, offertory (first collections) using the reported information for unrestricted plate and donations.

**How much will my parish receive as part of this campaign?** As part of the *We Are Living Stones* Capital Campaign, \$40 million will be allocated to help parishes meet their local needs. After the *Works of Mercy* target is met, 50% of all funds raised will stay at the parish for projects determined by local leadership.

**Is our parish goal an assessment?** No, the established parish goals are not an assessment. However, the first monies raised at each parish will be allocated to help meet the parish's "Works of Mercy" target. All parishes are asked to conduct a "good faith effort" and work with their assigned campaign director to achieve their goal. If, after conducting a "good faith effort" the parish does not meet its goal, the parish will not be assessed the balance.

**When will parishes begin to receive their 50 percent share?** Parishes in Block 1 can expect to receive their first distribution of 50% of monies collected in October of 2015. These payments will continue every quarter thereafter until the conclusion of the campaign. If the parish exceeds goal, they will receive 60% of all funds redeemed above the *We Are Living Stones* goal on the same timeline as stated above.

**How will the campaign affect our parish offertory?** In the short term, offertory giving should remain level, with a possible small fluctuation up or down. We make sure we communicate that parishioners are asked to consider a greater sacrifice and commitment to their Archdiocesan Church above and beyond their regular offertory giving, and should not lower their gifts to their parish in order to make a gift to this effort.


