

Dear Parishioners:

While meditating on today's great feast the image came to my mind of a sandwich. Last week with great solemnity we celebrated the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost and next weekend we celebrate Corpus Christi. Now between the Spirit and the Eucharist we contemplate the "meat" or the Holy Trinity. Each of these dogmas of our Faith is shrouded in mystery and cannot be without the other two. Something in us loves a mystery but there are those that cannot be solved, only experienced. They can be likened to love which is very difficult to define or explain unless you have had the experience of being loved.

It has been said that the entire Bible can be summed up in just three words, "God is Love". Often when I am preparing a couple for marriage or giving a baptismal prep I ask, "What is the most important thing you can give your children?" At times the answer is correct, "love". But then I ask, "Love for whom?" The response is usually, "Love for the children." Then I tell them, "Love for each other as spouses." I go on to explain that all studies show the same thing. Children who grow up in a home where the parents love each other have a 75% greater chance of a personal belief in God as adults. This should not surprise us since God is a family of love and unity. The more we strive to live the mystery of the Holy Trinity, the stronger our faith and our families will be.

Notas del Pastor

Estimados feligreses:

Mientras meditaba sobre la gran fiesta de hoy, la imagen de un sándwich vino a mi mente. La semana pasada, con gran solemnidad, celebramos la venida del Espíritu Santo en Pentecostés y el próximo fin de semana celebraremos la Solemnidad del Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo. Ahora entre el Espíritu y la Eucaristía contemplamos la "carne" o la Santísima Trinidad. Cada uno de estos dogmas de nuestra fe es un misterio y no pueden existir sin los otros dos. Algo en nosotros ama un misterio, pero hay misterios que no se pueden resolver, sólo experimentar. Esto se puede comparar al amor que es muy difícil de definir o explicar a menos que uno haya tenido la experiencia de ser amado.

Se ha dicho que toda la Biblia se puede resumir en tres palabras: "Dios es amor." A menudo, cuando estoy capacitando a una pareja para el matrimonio o estoy dando una clase de preparación bautismal, les pregunto: "¿Qué es la cosa más importante que ustedes pueden dar a sus hijos?" A veces la respuesta es correcta, "el amor." Pero entonces les pregunto, "El amor para quién?" La respuesta suele ser: "El amor por los niños." Entonces yo les digo, "El amor que ustedes tienen el uno para el otro como esposos." Les explico que todos los estudios muestran la misma cosa. Los niños que crecen en un hogar donde los padres se aman tienen un 75% más de probabilidades de una creencia personal en Dios como adultos. Esto no debe sorprendernos ya que Dios es una familia de amor y unidad. Cuanto más nos esforzamos por vivir el misterio de la Santísima Trinidad, más fuertes serán nuestra fe y nuestras familias.

How will the parish goals be determined? Parish goal calculations are based on 100 percent of the 2013, offertory (first collections) using the reported information for unrestricted plate and donations.

How much will my parish receive as part of this campaign? As part of the **We Are Living Stones** Capital Campaign, \$40 million will be allocated to help parishes meet their local needs. After the *Works of Mercy* target is met, 50% of all funds raised will stay at the parish for projects determined by local leadership.

Is our parish goal an assessment? No, the established parish goals are not an assessment. However, the first monies raised at each parish will be allocated to help meet the parish's "Works of Mercy" target. All parishes are asked to conduct a "good faith effort" and work with their assigned campaign director to achieve their goal. If, after conducting a "good faith effort" the parish does not meet its goal, the parish will not be assessed the balance.

When will parishes begin to receive their 50 percent share? Parishes in Block 1 can expect to receive their first distribution of 50% of monies collected in October of 2015. These payments will continue every quarter thereafter until the conclusion of the campaign. If the parish exceeds goal, they will receive 60% of all funds redeemed above the **We Are Living Stones** goal on the same timeline as stated above.

How will the campaign affect our parish offertory? In the short term, offertory giving should remain level, with a possible small fluctuation up or down. We make sure we communicate that parishioners are asked to consider a greater sacrifice and commitment to their Archdiocesan Church above and beyond their regular offertory giving, and should not lower their gifts to their parish in order to make a gift to this effort.


