We ask all this through the Intercession of our Blessed Mother, St. Francis, St. Clare and all Your Saints. Amen

# "Go from gospel to life and life to the gospel."

Evangelii Gaudium (The Joy of the Gospel) #127

"There is a kind of preaching which falls to each of us as a daily responsibility. It has to do with bringing the Gospel to the people we meet, whether they be our neighbors or complete strangers. This is the informal preaching which takes place in the middle of a conversation, something along the lines of what a missionary does when visiting a home. Being a disciple means being constantly ready to bring the love of Jesus to others, and this can happen unexpectedly and in any place: on the street, in a city square, during work, on a journey."

#### Rule #4

"The rule and life of the Secular Franciscans is this: to observe the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ by following the example of Saint Francis of Assisi, who made Christ the inspiration and the center of his life with God and people.

Christ, the gift of the Father's love, is the way to him, the truth into which the Holy Spirit leads us, and the life which he has come to give abundantly.

Secular Franciscans should devote themselves especially to careful reading of the gospel, going from gospel to life and life to the gospel."



### <u>Scripture for this Month</u> (Don't forget to pass along your favorite passages!)

Some of the passages offered below for reflection come from our members. Use them for your meditation on Scripture this month. When you look for those passages in the Bible, *try to read the verses or paragraphs that come before or after for a fuller meditation.* 



Rule: Articles 4 and 5 (Essential Documents book)

**Scripture:** Matthew 5: 13-16; John 17: 16-18

### **Lectio Divina** (A little review)

- Read [*Lectio*] (Read the scripture passage TWICE)
- Reflect [Meditatio] (Think about the passage—Which words stand out?—What is God telling us?)
- Respond [ Oratio] (Allow our hearts to respond to God. We pray over the Scripture passages in silence.)
- Rest [Contemplatio] (We put aside our own thoughts and listen with our hearts to the message of the scripture passage. We are gradually <u>transformed</u> by the message. What is our response to God?
