## REMINDER: \*ANY CHILD WHO HAS NOT ATTENDED RELIGIOUS EDUCATION CLASSES AT ST FRANCIS OR ANY OTHER PARISH IN 2 YEARS OR MORE WILL BE CONSIDERED A NEW STUDENT AND WILL HAVE TO COMPLETE 1 YEAR OF BASIC CATECHISM PRIOR TO ENTERING A SACRAMENT PREPARATION PROGRAM.

### PRECEPTS OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

ALL CHILDREN WHO HAVE RECEIVED THE SACRAMENT OF FIRST HOLY COMMUNION ARE REQUIRED TO: ATTEND SUNDAY MASS, CONFESS THEIR SINS AT LEAST ONCE A YEAR, RECEIVE HOLY COMMUNION FREQUENTLY

### IV. RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR CHILDREN AND ADULTS (RCIA):

- These classes are for the un-baptized who wish to become Christians and members of the Catholic Church.
- RCIA can be adapted to other baptized Christian adults seeking membership in the Catholic Church.
- > This is a TWO-YEAR PROGRAM.

\*Registration is BY APPOINTMENT ONLY.

### V. PARENT CATECHESIS IN ENGLISH AND SPANISH:

- 1. <u>MANDATORY REQUIREMENT:</u> At least one parent of the candidates for Reconciliation and 1<sup>st</sup> Communion and Confirmation must attend adult catechesis, so that they can teach their children at home.
- 2. <u>Class will meet TWICE a month during the Wednesday Sacramental Preparation classes from</u> <u>October 2016 thru April 2017</u>
- 3. Registration for parents is FREE and will be done at the time of child's registration.
- 4. Certificates will be awarded upon completion of requirement.
- 5. OTHER PARENTS/ADULTS ARE ENCOURAGED TO PARTICIPATE AND JOIN THE CLASS.
