# Questioning by the Celebrant

Celebrant: Before this fraternity and the other members of the People of God gathered here, I ask you to express your will. <u>Do you wish to embrace the Gospel way of life</u> by following the example and words of St. Francis of Assisi, which are at the <u>heart of the</u> <u>Rule of the Secular Franciscan Order</u>?

Candidate(s): YES, THIS IS WHAT I WANT.

Celebrant: You have been <u>called to give witness to the Kingdom of God</u> and to <u>build a</u> <u>more fraternal world based on the Gospel</u>, together with all people of goodwill. Do you wish to be <u>faithful to this vocation</u> and to practice the spirit of service proper to Secular Franciscans?

Candidate(s): YES, THIS IS WHAT I WANT.

Celebrant: You have been made (a) member(s) of the People of God by your <u>Baptism</u>, <u>and strengthened in Confirmation by the new gift of the Spiri</u>t, in order to <u>proclaim</u> <u>Christ by your life and your words</u>. Do you wish to <u>bind yourselves (self) more closely</u> <u>to the Church</u> and to work intently to rebuild the ecclesial community and fulfill its mission among all people?

Candidate(s): YES, THIS IS WHAT I WANT.

Minister: The local fraternity is a visible sign of the Church, a community of faith and love. Together with all the members, you now <u>pledge yourselves (self) to spend your</u> <u>efforts to make the fraternity a genuine ecclesial assembly and a living Franciscan community.</u>

What did we promise at Profession?

Therefore, in my secular state I promise to <u>live all the days of my life the Gospel</u> of our Lord Jesus Christ in the Secular Franciscan Order <u>by observing its rule of life</u>.

May the grace of the Holy Spirit, the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary and our holy father St. Francis, and the fraternal bonds of community always be my help, so that I may reach the goal of perfect Christian love.

DURING THE RITE OF PROFESSION: Maureen and Pam will receive:

**The Gospels**—As Secular Franciscans we need to be very familiar with the words of Scripture since we promise to "go from Gospel to life and life to the Gospel." (Rule Art. 4)

**The Crucifix**—We are reminded of the Sacrifice our Lord Jesus made for our salvation. Francis's devotion to the Incarnation (the Crib and the Cross) are central to our lives as Franciscans.

**The Candle--** We received a candle at Baptism representing the light of Christ. This candle reminds us that we have re-committed to the promises that were made for us at Baptism and the promises we made at Confirmation. We are to bring the light of Christ to others.
